

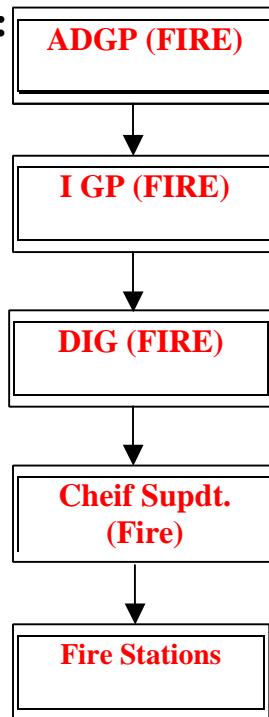
Police Fire Servies, M.P.

1. Introduction :

The first Police Fire station was established at Motitabela Indore, in the year 1905, by the Holkar King, Maharaja Yashwant Rao Holkar. After the reorganization of the state of M.P., Police fire stations continued to be established even beyond the limits of Indore district for rendering emergency services in all cases of fires, natural calamities and disasters. At present, there are 6 (six) Police Fire Stations functioning in the state , one in Bhopl, Malanpur, Pithampur and three in Indore district. Fire services for the entire district of Indore is provided by the Police fire services, while the rest of the police fire stations established outside district Indore have duties in specified jurisdiction within the respective districts.

2. Duties and functions :-

1. To save life and property from fire.
2. To conduct rescue operations.
3. To assist/ evacuate people during natural calamities/disasters, such as floods, earthquakes etc.,
4. To educate and create public awareness for fire prevention and fire fighting.
5. To provide guidance to Hotels, Hospitals, Multistory Buildings, Factories, Cinema Houses etc., on fire fighting arrangements and fire safety requirements.
6. To co-ordinate among various agencies/departments such as Nagar Nigam, M.P.E.B., P.H.E.D. etc. to ensure better efficiency during any natural calamity/disaster.

4. Vehicles and equipments :

Of a total of 123 vehicles, the majority are special water Tenders, Foam / Co₂ / DCP Tenders with high and low pressure pumps. Specialized vehicles include a rescue Master, which contains various life saving equipments, such as Light Mast, Hydraulic Jack etc. It helps to save life in natural as well as manmade calamities.

The Hydraulic Platform cum turn table which can be very useful during fires in high rise buildings is a highly sophisticated vehicle fitted with a ladder which can reach a height up to 32 mtrs. which can be very useful during Fires in high rise buildings.

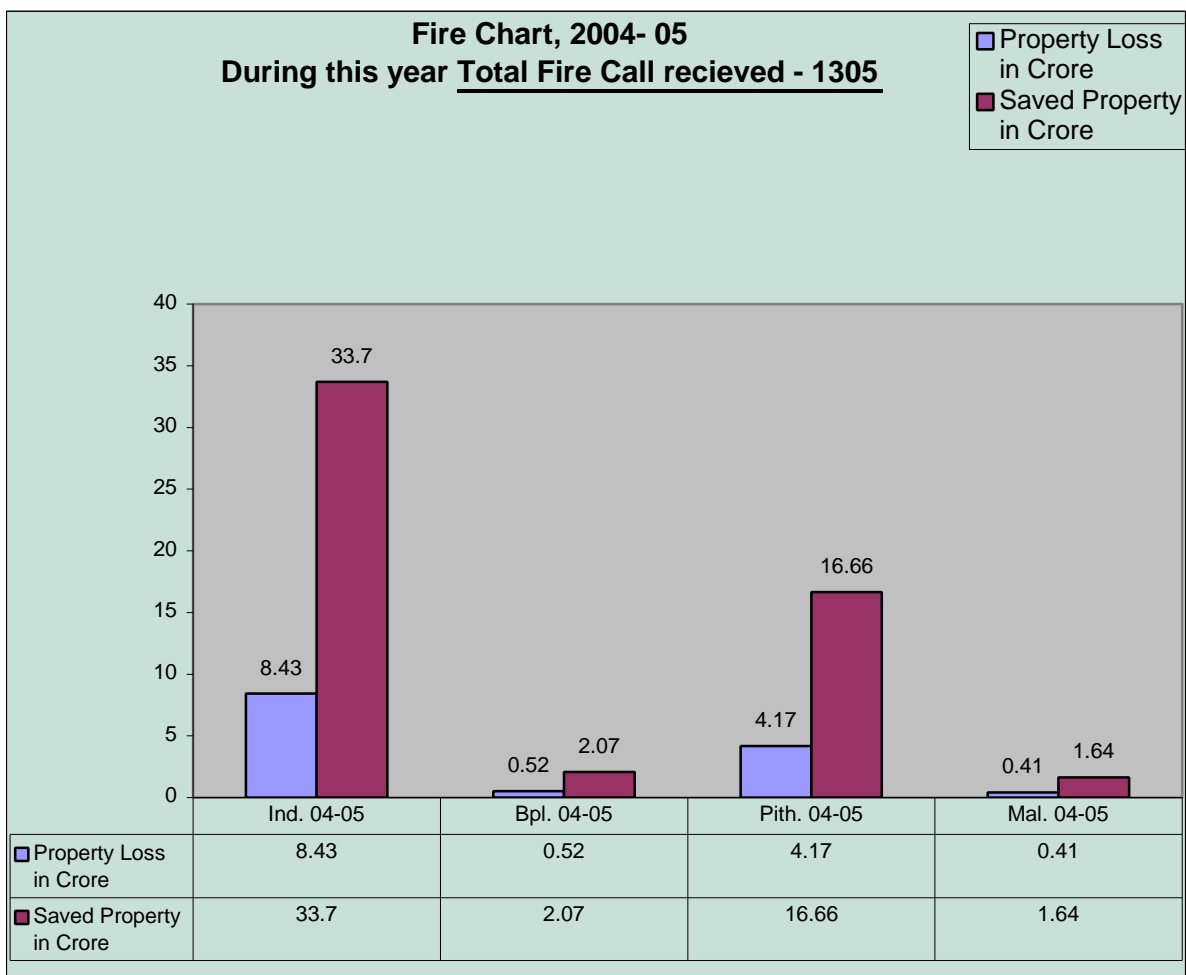
5. Achievements of the department :

Since its inception, the Police fire service has set an example of excellence in fire fighting and rescue operations. The following chart gives a clear picture of the total number of persons and property saved by the department.

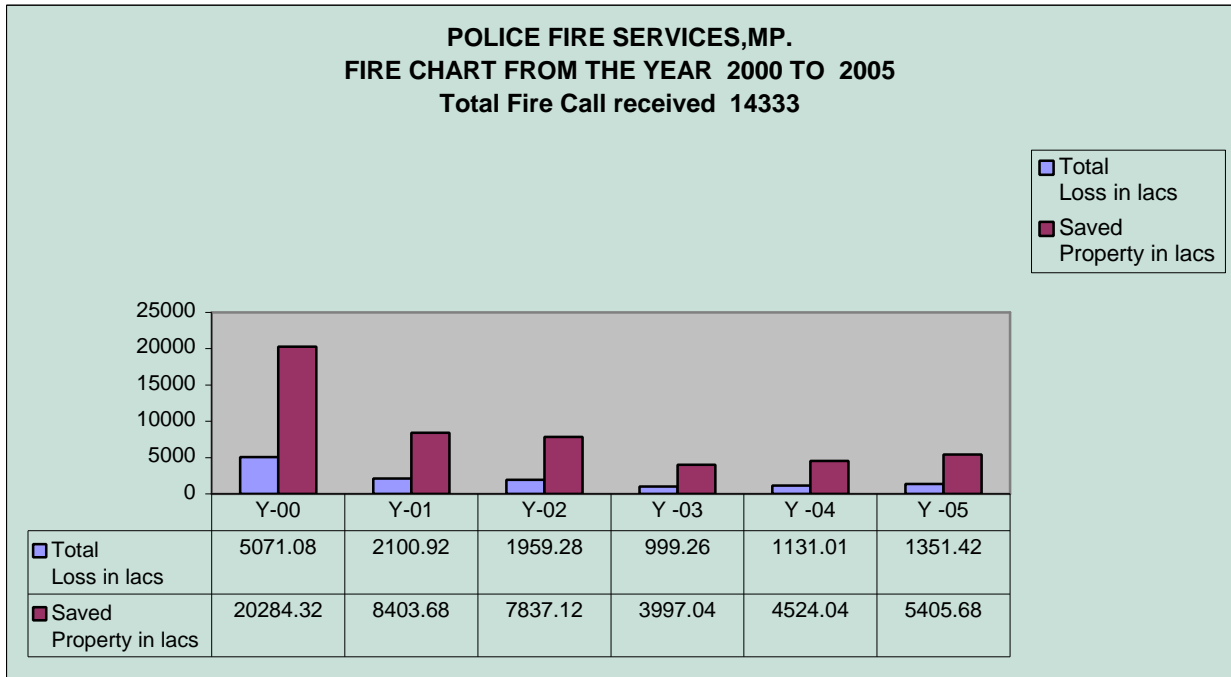

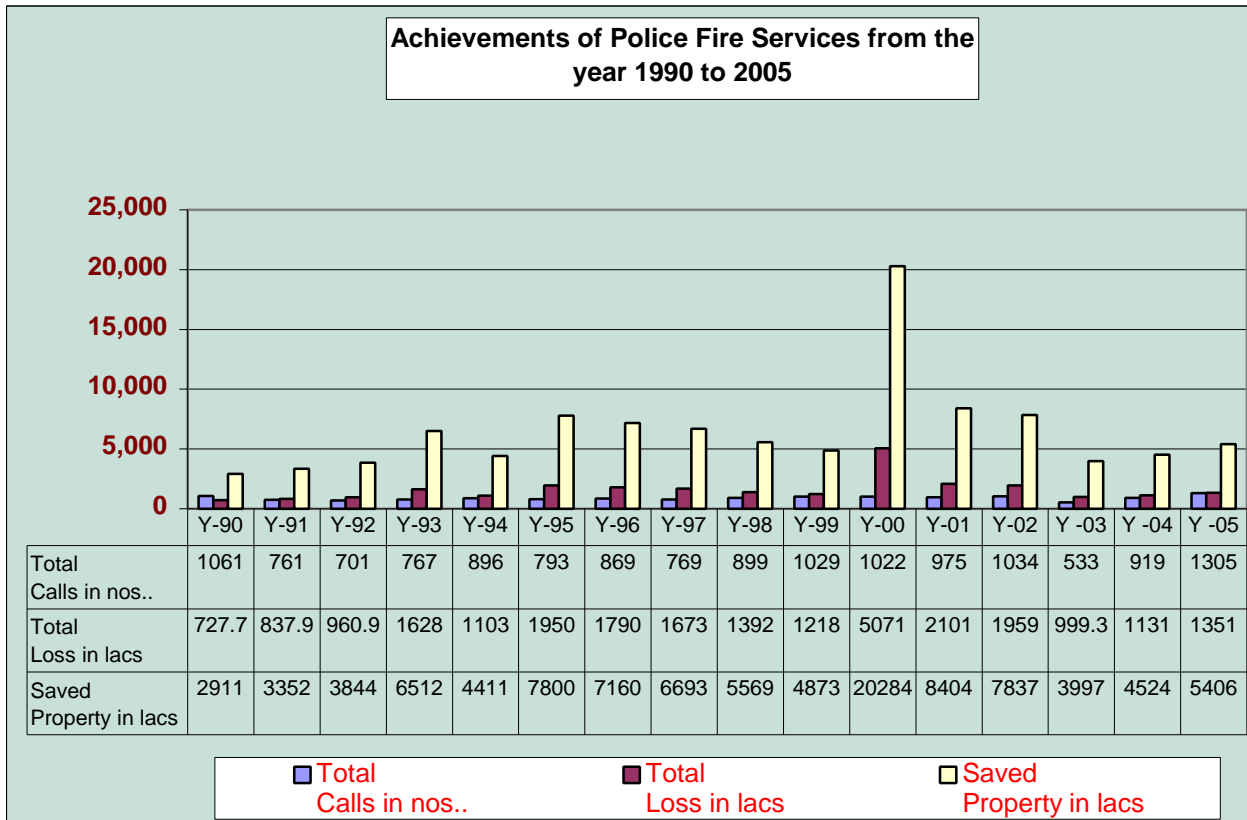
FIRE CHART DURING THIS YEAR 2004-05 :-
